INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BRAGG 'N BARN SCHOLARSHIP:

- Conditions of Eligibility: The applicant must be the dependent of an active duty or AGR service member assigned to Fort Bragg, or of a retired service member whose last duty station was Fort Bragg or Pope Army Airfield and the service member still lives within a 50 mile radius from any direction of Fort Bragg.
- Applicants must be enrolled or accepted to a full-time accredited college for the fall of 2021. High school applicants must have a **minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 scale**.
College students must have a **minimum cumulative GPA of 2.85 out of 4.0**
- College freshmen must submit a first semester college transcript and a high school transcript.
- Applicants who receive an appointment to any US Military Academy (or affiliated prep schools) will be ineligible for the Bragg 'N Barn Scholarship.
- Applicants must be working on a two or four-year, undergraduate accredited degree program.
- Any scholarships awarded will be sent directly to the college/university and is to be used for tuition, fees, board, books and qualified expenses for the academic year 2021-22.
- All decisions made by the the Bragg 'N Bar Scholarship Committee are final.
- DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION FOR THE BRAGG 'N BARN SCHOLARSHIP IS
- 31 MARCH 2021. ANY APPLICATION RECEIVED WITH A POSTMARK AFTER 31 MARCH 2021 WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED.
